INTERNAL AUDIT REPORT

PARISH COUNCIL - MONK FRYSTON

YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2017

The Receipts and Payments account of Monk Fryston Parish Council was examined for audit.

- 1. The Cash Book opening and closing balances in respect of the Current and Savings account are in accordance with the closing bank balances at 31 March 2017.
- **2.** No VAT omissions were identified from the VAT records maintained by the Parish Council.
- 3. A small underpayment was identified owing to the Monk Fryston, Hillam & Burton Salmon Joint Burial Committee of £2.00. The precept due to the JBC is £1.177.25 and £1.175.25 was paid. The omission has not been identified by the JBC at this time. It is **recommended** the underpayment be made.
- **4.** Expenditure analysis (Expenditure Breakdown schedule) does not include a full analysis in every case of the individual expense making up the total. Certain expenditure has been lumped together. For example: Asset purchase NYCC £4,906.76 is not one single cost as is the case for payments made to S G Parkin £2,280.00. It is **recommended** the expenditure heading should show each single item of expense and not shown as one total in order to aid clarity.
- 5. The Receipts and Payments Account has an expenditure heading 'Projects' with a cost of £9,473.21. I have referred to this cost heading in previous audit reports, viz 31 March 2014. In order to be more transparent, it is my belief that this cost heading should only refer to a project or projects where the parish council have one or more than one undertaking, being one off specific expenditure.

The expenditure currently charged under this heading is a miscellany of costs which could be allocated under more appropriate cost headings. For example: Landscaping & Gardening, Repairs and Renewals, General Administration for items as printing, legal fees, donations for the Remembrance Wreath etc. Such costs could initially fall under General Administration and then a sub-analysis produced to cover the cost headings. The analysis under General Administration could, therefore, become 'Notes to the Accounts'.

The costs under Projects for the current year, 2016/2017, represents 35.58% of the total expenditure of £26,627.

It is **recommended** the members consider for future years, eliminating the cost heading Projects and only retain it for a specific purpose.

I have looked through your account and it seems that we have been completing 1 inspection/treatment for the past 2 years 2015 & 2016. To confirm eradication of Japanese knotweed, there will have to be 2 clear seasons on no growth, and from looking at last years' Site Visit Report (as attached), there was no sign of Japanese knotweed in that main area, however, some sprigs were found on the bank adjoining main street and on the railway land but no sign in the field. Would you like us to complete another treatment/inspection this year? I look forward to hearing from you.
